

# Koi-Koi Yaku (sets) Guide

There are 12 sets (yaku) that you can form. Most of these are based around 4 categories of cards.

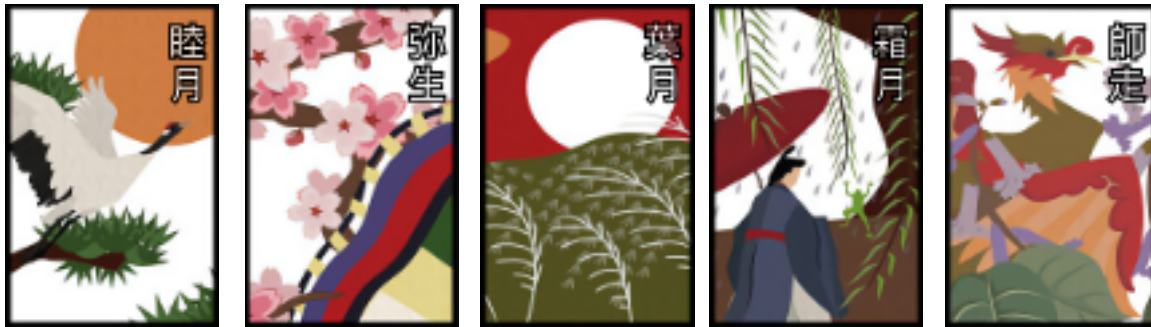
Brights, Ribbons, Animals, or Plain Cards.

You may wish to print this out for a guide while learning the game.

## The Yaku

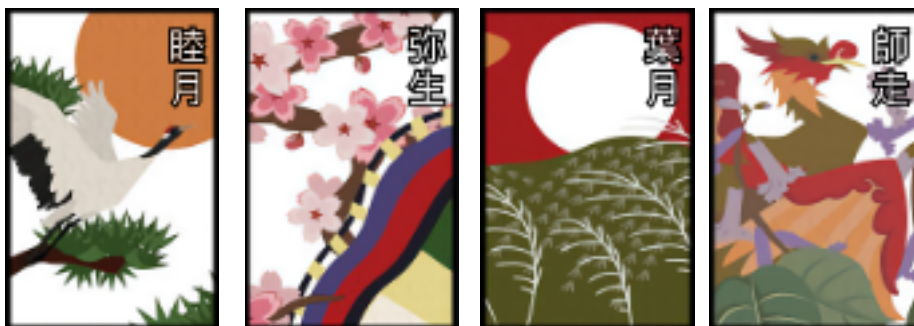
Gokō (五光) – Five Brights - 15 points

**All 5 Brights**

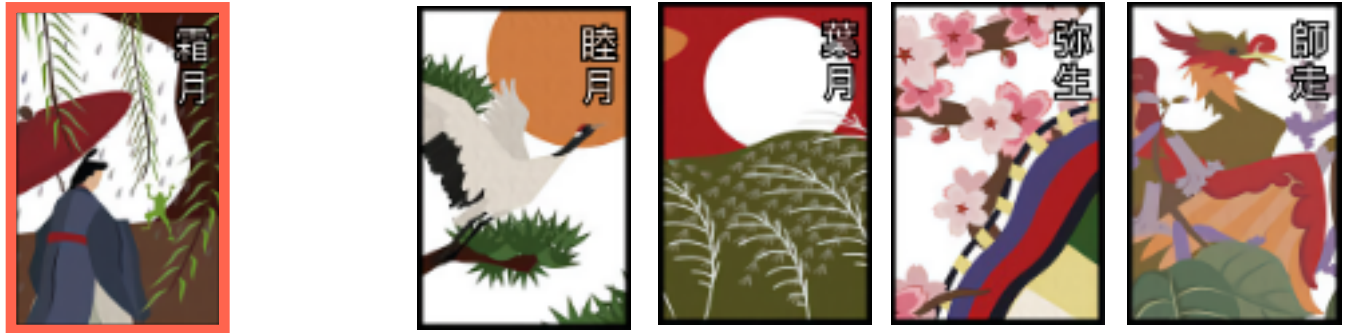


Shikō (四光) – “Dry” Four Brights - 10 points

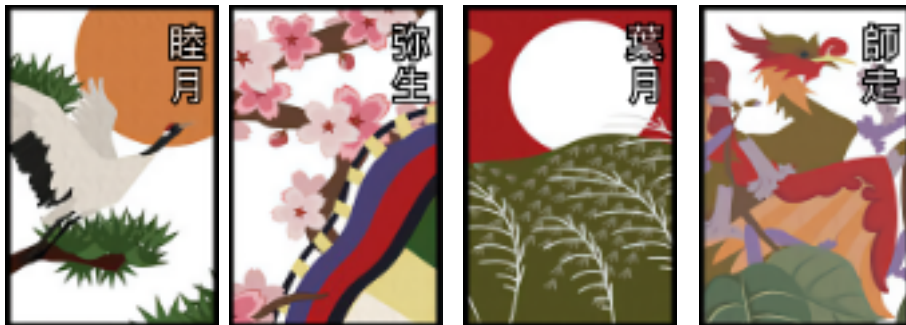
**4 Brights not including Rain Card**



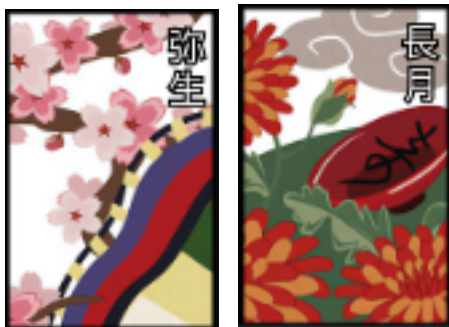
Ame-Shikō (雨四光) – Rainy Four Brights - 8 points  
Rain Card and any 3 of the other Brights



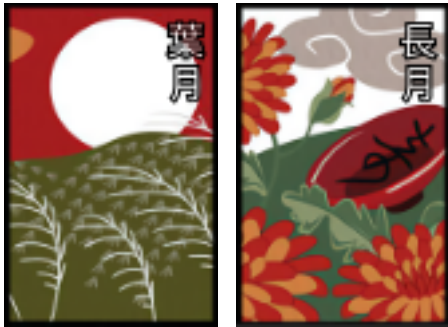
Sankō (三光) – “Dry” Three Brights - 6 points  
Any 3 brights (not including Rain Card)



Hanami-zake (花見酒) – Blossom Viewing - 5 points



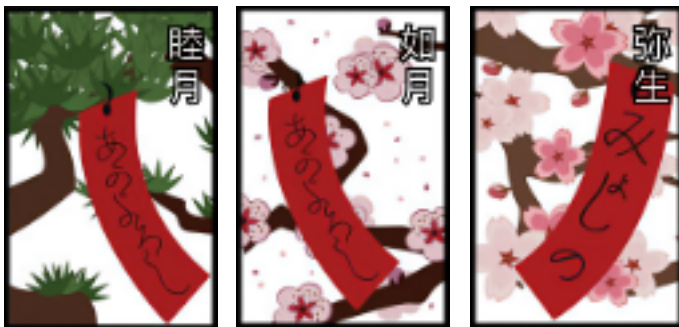
Tsukimi-zake (月見酒) – Moon Viewing - 5 points



Ino-shika-chō (猪鹿蝶) – Boar, Deer, Butterfly - 5 points



Akatan (赤短) – 3 Poetry Ribbons - 5 points  
3 red ribbons with poetry written on them



Aotan (青短) – 3 Blue Ribbons - 5 points



Tanzaku (短冊) – 5 Ribbons - 1 point

Any 5 ribbons + 1 point for each additional ribbon



Tane (タネ) – Seeds (Five Animals) - 1 point

Any 5 animal cards - 1 point bonus for each additional card





Kasu (カス) – 10 Plain - 1 point

Any 10 plain cards + 1 point for each additional card
